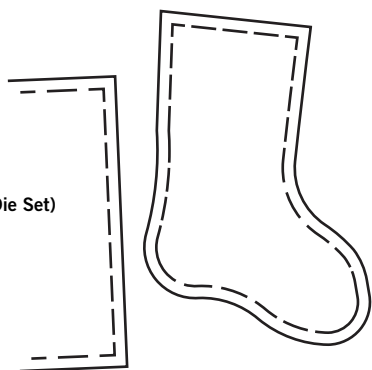


Stocking (2-Die Set)
(50745)



CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Red fabric:

Cut 1 pair of stockings

White fabric:

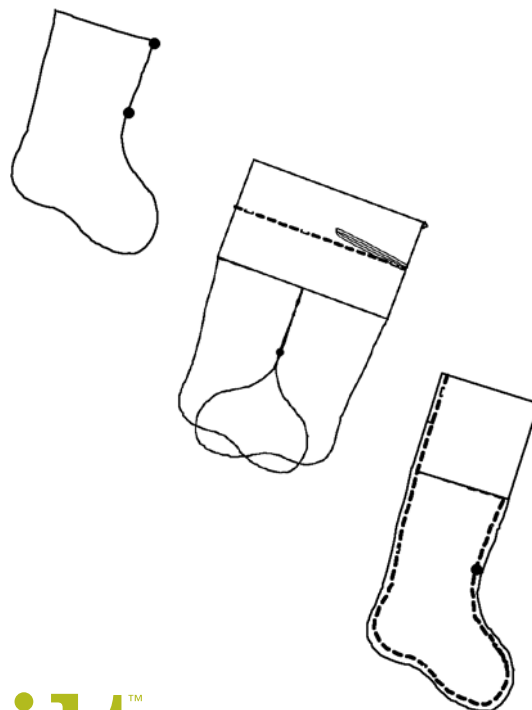
Cut 1 cuff with fabric folded along the open side of the rectangle

SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Pin and sew instep of stocking with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, right sides together, between dots as shown.
2. Press partial seam open.
3. Open out stocking with top edge flat.
4. Fold cuff in half wrong sides together and press a center crease (shown as dotted line in second diagram).
5. Press under $\frac{1}{4}$ " on one long raw edge of cuff.
6. Pin and sew other long raw edge of cuff to top edge of stocking with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, right sides together.
7. Press seam toward cuff.
8. Cut 8" of ribbon for hanger.
9. Fold ribbon in half.
10. Pin tails of ribbon at cuff crease so ribbon is lying on cuff as shown.
11. Pin and sew stocking and cuff right sides together as shown, sewing ribbon into seam. Begin stitching at dot, completing partially sewn instep seam.
12. Reinforce stitching over ribbon to secure.
13. Clip curves of seam allowance.
14. Turn right sides out and press.
15. Fold cuff toward inside of stocking along pressed cuff crease.
16. Pin $\frac{1}{4}$ " pressed edge to inside of stocking covering stitching.
17. Topstitch or hand stitch cuff in place.

Quilter's Tip

Decorate stocking with die cut alphabet or die cut shapes such as Holly (50683).



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
