

BOM2021B07 Liberty Legacy Star

TIPS *

Always remove any salvage before cutting.
Seams are 1/4" unless noted.
BG always refers to Back Ground Fabric.
Directions are for One Block unless noted.
Use lots of your preferred sizing.
Starch draws insects so if you use that instead finish in a timely manner and wash your **completed** quilt, bindings included.
Press fabric well before cutting.
Flat smooth fabric is critical to a good cut.
The stiffer, the better!

With this block you can use the ideas that were discussed in the introduction to create visual impact.

Use the tools (10 and 15 step grayscale, red and green acrylic) with your fabrics to see the values or follow an example image. It can be difficult to see the differences.

Since I have discussed the theory this will be piecing instructions.

Sometimes its easier to follow your favorite quilters sewing instructions.

Fabrics: Each fabric needs to be marked with a letter.

Above is an example in general order from a - k and m.

Be sure to use your background fabric in the block where it fits the grayscale.

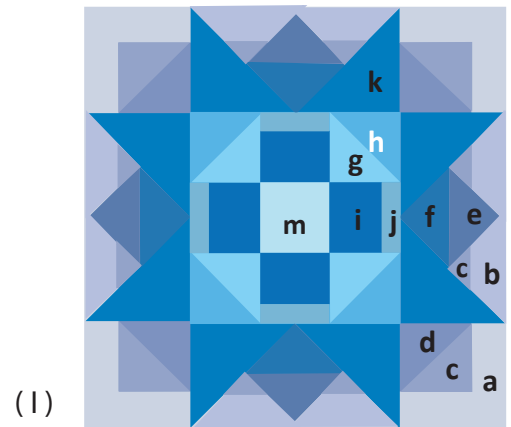
Some like to make a chart using a scrap for each fabric.

Since some colors may be so alike please keep a label with each fabric.

Note: Sometimes flipping to the back side of a fabric will change the color.

Please forgive any less math than usual as my brain can't do it right now.

Here and there is allowed for trimming. Not much.



Cut: 1 of g - 5 3/4" square
1 of c - 5 3/4" square
1 of d - 5 3/4" square
1 of e - 5 3/4" square
1 of f - 5 3/4" square
43" x 1 1/2" of - b
43" x 1 1/4" of - c

1 of h - 5 3/4" square
4 of i - 2 1/2" square
4 of c - 2 1/2" x 1 1/4"
1 of m - 2 1/2" square
4 of k - 4 1/2" square
30" x 1 3/4" of - a
